

The Erasmus+ Programme (2021-2027)

- EU Action Programme for Cooperation in Education
- Multiple funding: up to 12 months in each study program (Bachelor + Master) at universities in participating EU member states
- No tuition fees, simplified admission conditions
- Erasmus grant (scholarship)
- Participation in intensive language courses

Funding through Erasmus+

- Participants receive a scholarship (amount depends on country group)*:
 - Country group 1 (e.g. France, Norway, Sweden): 600 euros per month
 - Country group 2 (e.g. Estonia, Hungary, Spain): 540 euros per month

Partner institutes	Places and duration
University of Zaragoza (Spain)	2 places of 10 months each (if necessary 4 places of 5 months each*)
University of Tartu (Estonia)	2 places of 5 months each (if necessary 1 place for 10 months each*)
Corvinus University of Budapest (Hungary)	1 place of 10 months (if necessary 2 places for 5 months each*)

Corvinus University of Budapest

- Prerequisite: English B2
- Cooperation with the Faculty of Social Sciences and International Relations -Department of Communication and Media Science
 - Bachelor and Master: Communication and Media Studies
- Courses: e.g. New Media Literacy, The Art of Persuasion, Cross Cultural Communication and marketing

University of Tartu

- 13,000 students, 9 faculties, courses partly in English
- Prerequisite: English B2
- Estonian course recommended on site
- Cooperation with the Institute of Journalism and Communication (Ajakirjanduse Yes Communication Institute)
- Bachelor's and Master's programs
 - Bachelor: Focus on Journalism and Public Relations
 - Master: Journalism and Communication Management
- Courses: e.g., Information Society and New Media, Introduction to Internet Studies
- Courses 3 & 6 ECTS each







Universidad de Zaragoza

- 38,000 students, 10 faculties
- Cooperation with the Departmento de Linguistica (Department of Linguistics)
 General e Hispanica, Area de Periodismo (German: journalism)



- Courses only in Spanish
- Prerequisite: Spanish B1 (recommended B2)

- Around 20 places for FSU students at the following six universities:





ERASMUS+ Bewerbung erfolgreich? Herzlichen Glückwunsch! Jetzt trennen Sie nur noch wenige (organisatorische) Schritte von Ihrem Auslandsabenteuer. Sie finden hier alle notwendigen Informationen zu den einzureichenden Unterlagen vor, während und nach Ihrem Auslandsaufenthalt.

Vor Beginn des Auslandsauferthalts beantragen Sie das ERASMUS- Stipendium, unterzeichnen die Friedrevenishangung und können sich ift das Semsetsfor Studierjahr beurabuen lassen. Zusätzlich legen Sie in Ihrem Learning Agreement die Kurse fest, die Sie in Musland besuchen werden und geben an, welche davon für ihr Studium anngerechnet werden sollen. Das Learning Agreement muss auch bei nachträglichen Anderungen in der Kursewahl überarbeitet werden. Im Ausland angekommen, lassen Sie sich ihre Ankunft im Certificate of Armals vom dortigen in ternational office bestätigen. Vor Abreise benötigen Sie ebenfalls eine Bestätigung von der Gasthochschule über die exalte Aufenthaltsdauer, den Letter of Confirmation. Wichtig ist nach dem Auslandsaufenthalt das Transcript of Becords (Notenübersicht) von der Gasthochschule. Abschließend schreiben Sie einen Erfahrungsbericht und füllen den EU-Fraeboeen aus.

The application

Requirements

- Enrollment at FSU for full-time study
- Application is usually in the 3rd semester (BA) or 1st semester (MA) [1st BA semester is also possible]
- Sufficient language skills for the target country or the language of instruction at the target university
- Completeness of the application documents



The application

Application documents (applies to exchange places of IfKW)

- Motivation letter
- Tabular resume (CV)
- Proof of grades (from Friedolin)
- Language certificates (English B2, and other language depending on the target university)

The application

Deadline

- Applications until <u>January 15, 2025</u> for the coming academic year (regardless of whether it is for the winter semester 2025/26 or the summer semester 2026)
- Places are expected to be allocated in February 2025

Selection criteria


- Quality of the motivation letter (35%)
- Individual academic achievements (grade point average) (35%)
- Language skills (beyond the required language level) (10%)
- Social commitment (10%)
- Form of application (10%)

Preparation for the stay abroad

To-Do after confirmation of a place

- Acceptance of the place (declaration of acceptance)
- Filling out and submitting the application documents to the foreign host university (note the deadlines)
- Dormitory application
- Complete the Learning Agreement and have it signed by the subject coordinator and the Internationales Büro (proof of completing 30 ECTS per semester)
- Application for ERASMUS grant in the Internationales Büro
- Application for Auslands-Bafög
- Application for leave of absence at the Student Service Center



Period	To Dos
January	Applicationfor exchange places
February	Acceptance of a university place
February/March	Nomination by subject coordinator (Registration at the foreign university)
March/April	Application documents to foreign university Application for Auslands-Bafög if necessary
June (winter semester) / December(summer semester)	Agreement on creditable achievements and complete the learning agreement
July 1st - August 1st (winter semester)/ - December 15th (summer semester)	Application for ERASMUS+ scholarship
July (winter semester)/ February (summer semester)	Leave of absence
1-2 weeks before departure	Notification of arrival (date and time) at foreign university


